

HAY, MANURE AND SOIL MANAGEMENT

If grass or vegetation must be removed from a treated area, it must only be placed or fed to livestock on **permanent grass pastures** or **rangeland** where loss of legumes or sensitive broadleaf species can be tolerated. Clippings from grass which have been treated with Corteva Agriscience™ herbicides should never be used for composting nor mulching.

Manure from livestock consuming treated grass should never be used for compost or around susceptible plants. It should only be used in permanent grass pastures and rangeland where loss of legumes or sensitive broadleaf species can be tolerated.

Soil from treated areas should never be moved to areas where sensitive plants may be planted within 5 years.
